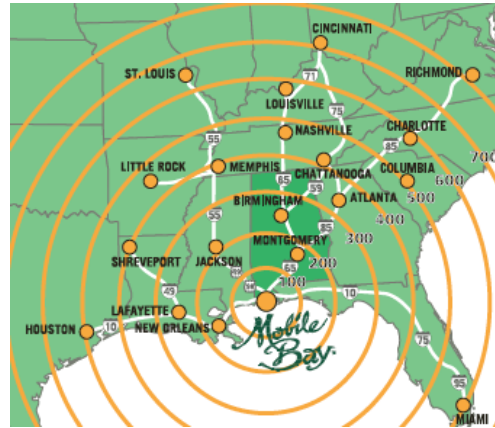
Carnival's 2007 Cruise port of the year
